

## What you need:

Your Epson printer with Epson genuine ink

A4 paper

Scissor

1,5 kg gingerbread dough

4 packs of gelatin sheets

1 kg caster sugar

2 egg whites

Piping bag

Glue gun and glue

2-3 small battery operated christmas lights

## **Instructions:**

Print the sheets.

Cut out the templates. Also cut out windows and doors.

Roll out the gingerbread dough, 4-5 mm thick. Have some plastic film under the dough, to make it is easier to move the houses onto the baking sheets.

Place the template on top of the dough and cut along the edges with a small knife. Move the gingerbread houses to the baking sheets.

Bake the gingerbread houses according to the instructions on the package. Let them cool.

Put some flour on the gingerbread houses. Brush them afterwards with some paper towels. Glue the gelatin sheets to the back of the gingerbread houses.

Make the icing. Mix 500 g of icing sugar with 1 egg white. The icing should be quite thick. If it is to thin, add some more icing sugar. If it is too thick, add a few drops of water. Plaze the icing in a thick piping bag. Cut a small hole.

Decorate the gingerbread houses with icing. Use your imagination.

Glue the houses together with a glue gun. Install lights behind the houses and decorate with artificial snow and small Christmas trees or similar.
