This is a perfect, easy and fun craft to do with your kids.

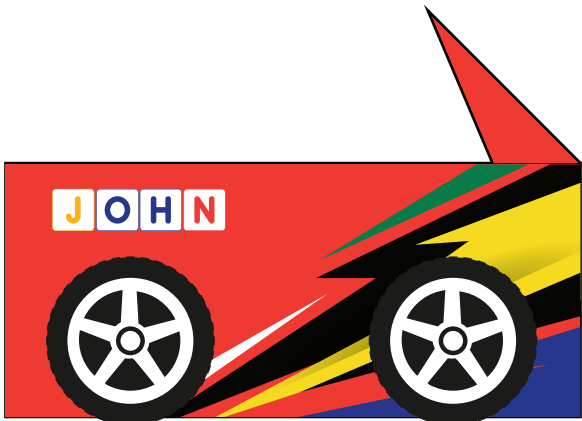




**What you need:**

- An Epson EcoTank Printer
- Box
- Plain A4 printing paper
- Scissors
- A glue stick

## Instructions



### Step 1

Download the printables and print. Remember to print extra pages of the items you will need more than one of. For example, 4 wheels.



### Step 2

Stick the printed wheels, lights, licence plate and steering wheel to the box and cut them out. Keep these aside.



### Step 3

Get creative and create your own design. Use the full-page prints to cover your box.



### Step 4

Glue the wheels, lights, licence plate and steering wheel to the box car. Customise your car by using the alphabet printable to add a name to your fancy car. The addition of a South African flag printable, as a small flag, will surely dazzle.



### Step 5

Play and have fun! Set up a movie night using your box cars and an Epson projector to create a “drive-in movie” experience.

\*Depending on the size of the box you'll be using to build your box car, you may need to print more than one copy of some pages.

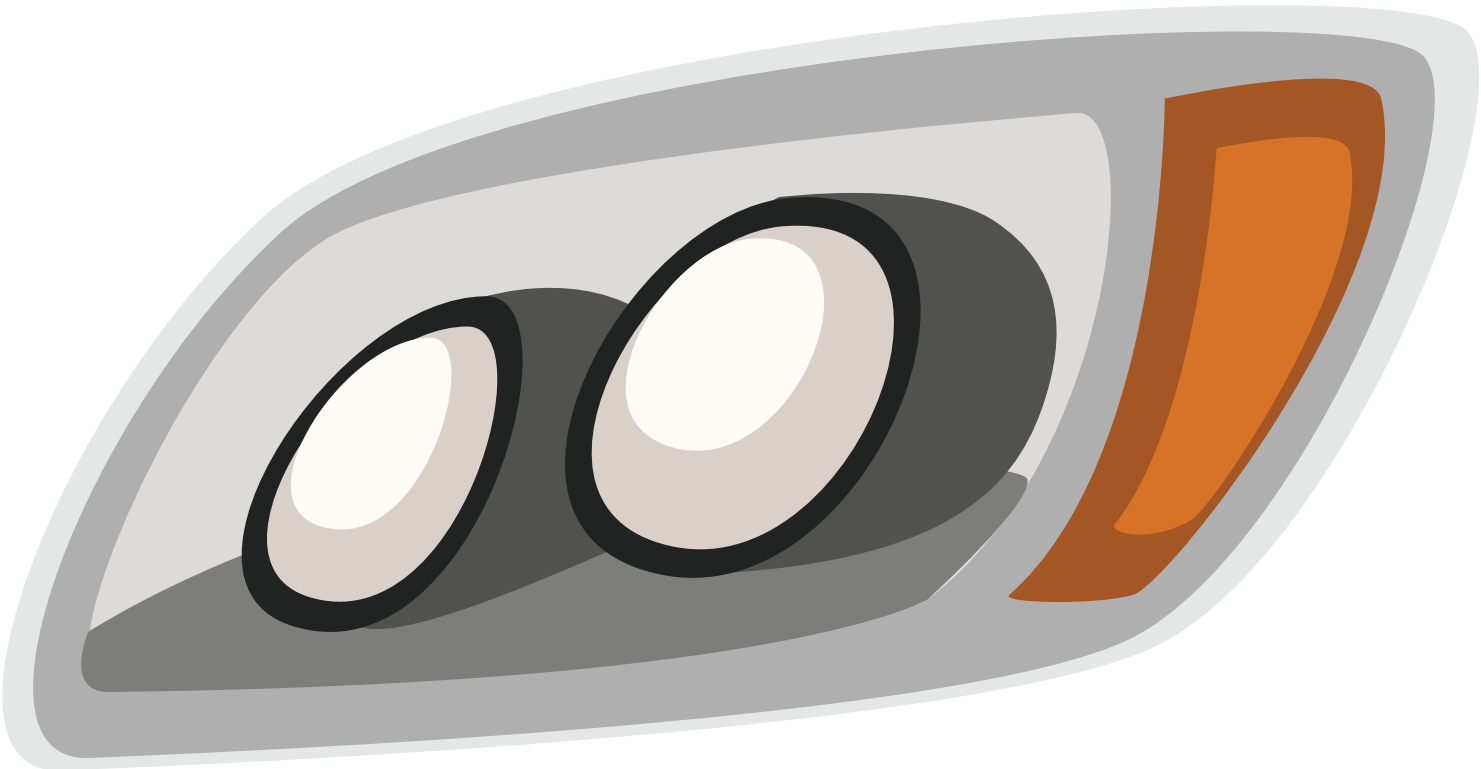
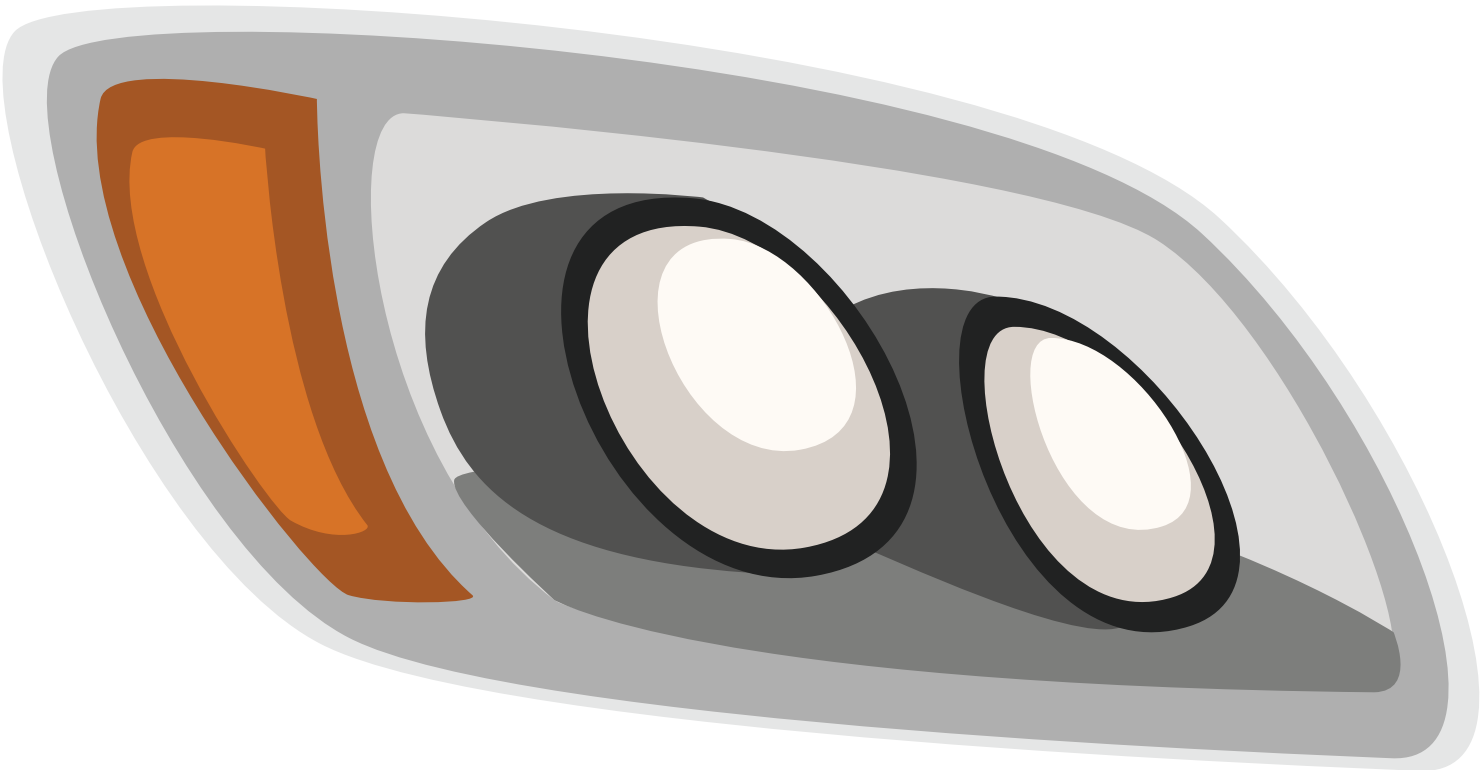
